

A Message from our Superintendent

The Yonkers Public Schools, fourth largest in New York State, is dedicated to the academic success of every student while supporting their social and emotional well-being. Over 27,000 students are enrolled in the District's thirty-eight schools – 10 prekindergarten to grade six schools, 20 prekindergarten to grade eight schools, 1 prekindergarten to grade twelve Montessori school, 2 grade seven to twelve schools and 5 high schools grades nine to twelve. These school configurations provide students with familiarity of environment, and results in higher levels of achievement, improved attendance, and more rigorous high school course offerings. Highly qualified educators instruct an array of innovative and relevant curricula while emphasizing post-secondary goals.

Who are Yonkers students? Seventy-seven point four percent (77.4%) are considered economi-

cally disadvantaged. Our students are 55.6% Hispanic, 24.5% are White and others, and 19.9% are African American. Fifteen point one percent (15.1%) of our total enrollment are classified as Students with Disabilities and 11.5% are Limited English

Proficient (LEP).

Yonkers students are progressing in the right direction working hard to improve academic success. Districtwide there are incremental gains on New York State assessments.

Yonkers outperforms by many measures the State's big five school districts - New York City, Buffalo, Rochester and Syracuse. Annual improvements exist in 3rd through 8thgrade English Language Arts and Mathematics proficiency. The graduation rate is up and is slightly below the State average with Advanced Designation diplomas increasing as well, and the dropout rate continues to decrease. Students are scoring higher grades on Regents exams in all five required subjects and more students are achieving the Aspirational Performance Measure designed to assess college and career readiness.Since 2008, Yonkers high schools have earned U.S.

News & World Report ranking as America's Best High Schools. In 2015, three schools were recognized – Yonkers Middle High School, an International Baccalaureate World School, received Gold status, Saunders Trades & Technical High School received Silver status and Lincoln High School received Bronze status.

The new collaboration between the City of Yonkers and the Board of Education through the Inter Municipal Agreement (IMA) of June 2014 has provided significant efficiencies across the Finance, Personnel & Human Resources, Legal, Communications & Public Information and Technology functions. The success of the Yonkers IMA will serve as a model for large city school districts across the state seeking to realize cost savings and operational efficiencies.






"When my family and I decided we needed to move Curto's to a larger showroom due to our growing business, I reached out to several business leaders and influencers whose
