





### Member profile: Family Service Society of Yonkers

Established in 1883, Family Service Society of Yonkers (FSSY) offers a broad range of programs and services for residents of Westchester County, especially for those in Yonkers. A premier provider of human services, FSSY focuses on home health care, support for families, guardianship, education and advocacy for individuals and families.

### Programs sponsored by Family **Service Society of Yonkers include** the following:

Home Health Care provides culturally-sensitive home-based nursing, aide and support services for the frail elderly and the physically disabled.

Home Health Care Training offers free Department of Health-approved home health care training programs leading to New York State certification as a Personal Care Aide and the more advanced Home Health Aide.

Geriatric Care Management helps family members faced with the dilemma of long-distance caregiving for their loved ones. Specially trained and culturally sensitive social workers provide comprehensive assessment, care planning and implementation, and complete follow-up services to clients and their families.

**Guardianship**: FSSY is appointed by the New York State Supreme Court in Westchester and Bronx Counties to act as legal guardian for incapacitated adults who are in danger of neglect, abuse and/or financial exploitation.

Representative Payee Services provides representative payee services for individuals approved by the Department of Social Services, as well as for private referrals on a feefor-service basis.

Homestead and Turning Point **Programs** provide permanent supportive housing for disabled homeless individuals and oversees social services related to their care.

Case Management Services provides case management for residents of the Yonkers Municipal Housing Authority and Yonkers Section 8 Housing, ensuring that individuals receive essential services, entitlements and appropriate health care.

**Housing Accessibility Program** provides accessibility and energysaving home modifications that enable low-income elderly and physically disabled Westchester County residents to continue living independently in their homes. Projects are approved by funding agencies and construction is performed by local licensed, insured contractors.

Kinship Support Program provides case management and peer support groups for relative caregivers, and holiday and summer programs for children raised by relative caregivers.

A range of additional social service programs targeted to kinship families is also offered.

**GrandPower Advocacy** sponsors advocacy training and legislative outreach to improve benefits for

relative caregivers and their children.

JCY-Westchester **Community** Partners JCY-Westchester Community Partners (JCY), a division of FSSY, sponsors the county's most extensive intergenerational literacy programs which pair volunteer mentors with students who need help.

These programs are offered in various public schools, libraries and hospital pediatric clinics in Yonkers, Mount Vernon, Elmsford, and White Plains. Executive Director, Seth Berman and the FSSY staff are dedicated to assisting Westchester residents in need as they seek to improve the lives of the county's vulnerable populations.

### New Member profile: iFLY



Indoor skydiving is the simulation of true freefall conditions in a vertical wind tunnel. It's where the dream of flight becomes a reality.

The Technology Behind Indoor Skydiving A vertical wind tunnel has fans at the top to draw air through the flight chamber and then push it back down the sides through Return Air Towers (RATs). The air is 'turned' from the RATs into the bottom of the tunnel (plenum) and back up toward the flight chamber through an inlet contractor.

The inlet contractor reduces the space the air can travel in, thus compressing and speeding up the air before it reenters the flight chamber. The result: a smooth column of air that enables you to fly.

### The Sport of Indoor Skydiving

The invention of modern wind tunnels has given skydivers a consistent and practical way to develop and hone skills that usually require jumping from a plane. Additionally, the increase in availability of wind tunnels has created a whole new genre of sport – bodyflight. It is one of the most exciting and fastest growing sports in the world.

If you have an interest in pursuing bodyflight as a sport, our instructors can design a training program to help you progress in your flying skills. iFLY also offers opportunities to get involved in local flight training nights that allow you to meet other participants and build your skills. Ultimately, you can compete in one of our local competitions that may include free-style and formation flying. 
**Advancing Your Flight Skills** The more you fly, the better you will become. And when you purchase coaching with dedicated iFLY






